

Il progetto “La Partecipazione delle Donne Libiche al Processo di Pacificazione e Ricostruzione del Paese”, attraverso il Seminario di Siracusa e il successivo di Roma, ha la finalità di chiarire, delineare e definire le azioni e il ruolo che le donne libiche, parlamentari e rappresentanti di associazioni e forum della società civile, intendono assumere e svolgere nel percorso di riconciliazione nazionale. L’iniziativa progettuale vuole far valere e ribadire i richiami della Risoluzione ONU 1325/2000, specificatamente sul contributo delle donne libiche al superamento della crisi in Libia che investe la sicurezza e la pace nel Mediterraneo. A Siracusa, con riferimento ai giovani tra violenza e speranza di futuro, alla relazione tra fedi religiose e cultura del rispetto, alla lotta contro estremismo e terrorismo, alle sfide prioritarie per la democrazia tra giustizia, istruzione e lavoro, e a quelle per le regolare le migrazioni incontrollate tra le due sponde del Mediterraneo.

*Through the Seminar in Syracuse and the subsequent one in Rome, the project “The participation of Libyan women in the country’s pacification and reconstruction process” aims to clarify, outline, and define the actions and the role that Libyan women, in parliament and representing associations and forums of civil society, intend to take on and perform in the path of national reconciliation. The project initiative aims to valorize and stress the appeals of UN Resolution 1325/2000, specifically on the contribution by Libyan women to overcoming the crisis in Libya, which is impacting peace and security in the Mediterranean. In Syracuse, the reference is to the youths poised between violence and hope in the future, to the relationship between religious faiths and the culture of respect, to the struggle against extremism and terrorism, to the priority challenges for democracy between justice, education, and labour, and to the challenges for regulating the unchecked migrations between the two shores of the Mediterranean.*
